The map of "Switzerland during the Last Glacial Maximum (LGM), 1:500,000" shows the maximum extent of glaciation in Switzerland at the height of the last Ice Age about 24,000 years ago. The Swiss Commission for Quaternary Research SKQ and Prof. Christian Schlüchter of the Institute for Geological Sciences at the University of Bern gathered the data and coordinated the scientific work. The Federal Office of Topography swisstopo is responsible for the cartographic work. The map published in 2009 presents the latest results of research on the Ice Age in Switzerland.
